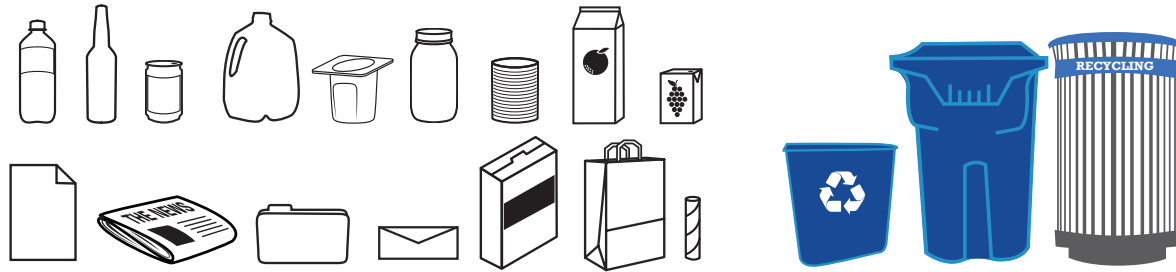

Recycled items are placed into indoor and/or outdoor recycling bins on campus

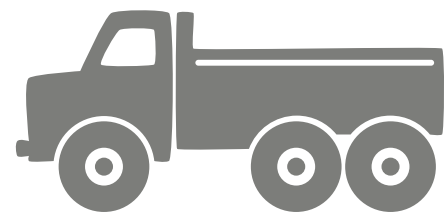


WHY RECYCLE

- Reduces greenhouse gas emissions

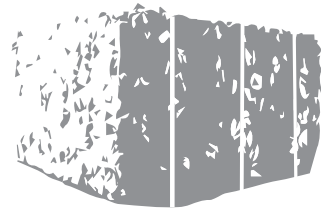

3 ITEMS YOU MIGHT NOT KNOW YOU CAN RECYCLE ON CAMPUS

Accepted in all bottles/cans recycling bins or commingled bins



YOGURT CONTAINERS

Make sure they are free of food residue before recycling

Can be recycled into recycling bins, shipping pallets and battery casings



PLASTIC BOTTLE CAPS

Screw the cap on the bottle so it is not lost during sorting

Caps can be melted down and made into razors, toothbrushes and plastic utensils



GABLE TOP CARTONS

Empty milk or juice cartons before recycling

Can be converted into pulp for raw materials in paper products and building materials
