### YES

- Aluminum cans
- Clean foil & tins
- Glass
- Steel cans
- Paperboard boxes
- Clean paper bags
- Newspaper
- Mixed paper
- Gable top cartons (ex. juice boxes & milk cartons)

### NO

- Food
- Plastic utensils
- Solo cups
- Styrofoam
- Plastic bags\*

## COMPOST



### YES

- All food (including meat, bones, dairy & eggshells)
- Napkins
- Paper plates
- Popcorn boxes
- Pizza boxes
- Coffee grounds
- Tea bags
- Wooden stir sticks
- Floral trimmings & leaves
- Certified compostable products made from corn & other plant starches

### NO

- Plastic
- Styrofoam
- Recyclables
- Foil
