Choose cups that are BPI certified and specifically labeled COMPOSTABLE.



Cheap wax-lined cups are a great option. These can be composted!



Use the real stuff! It's easy to BYO or to collect & wash at home.



ALL plastic utensils belong in the landfill.



Choose utensils that are **BPI certified & specifically** labeled COMPOSTABLE.



Bamboo chopsticks are inexpensive, fun, & can be composted!





Hosting a larger event that requires more bins for overflow waste?



There is no limit to the amount of times aluminum can be recycled. Cans can be a great choice!

> "Paper" plates sometimes come with a PLASTIC coating.

ALL plates with plastic belong in the landfill.

Choose plates that are BPI certified and/or contain no plastic. Palm leaf plates are a fun alternative!




The cheap, no-shine, white plates can be composted!
